# GENERAL INFORMATION

**Intended Audience:** This activity is designed for plastic surgeons at all levels of experience who want to increase their knowledge of the most up-to-date, innovative trends, procedures and strategies to implement in the practice of their specialty.

**Educational Overview:** Through participation in this activity, the attendee will improve competency and planning strategies and improve their skills in a variety of new techniques and procedures including but not limited to: the prevention of medical errors; avoiding complications; effective communication with patients concerning safety; various approaches to breast reconstruction including the use of ADM, treatment of capsular contracture, and latissimus flap options; techniques in abdominoplasty for body contouring; use and application of fat grafting in facial, breast and body applications; techniques in rhinoplasty; the use of lasers in facial rejuvenation; and an introduction to newest trends in plastic surgery via a hot topics segment; managing risk by effective patient selection, communication, and other practice management techniques. They will also gain understanding of the socio-political climate in which they practice in order to maintain compliance with regulations for the highest standards in patient care. With regard to regulation we are including a regulatory update with a compliance packet.

**ABMS Core Competencies:** This meeting will address the following ACGME/ABMS competencies: Patient Care; Medical Knowledge; Professionalism.

**Learner Objectives:** After attending this meeting the participants will be able to:

- Analyze, treat and initiate an appropriate surgical plan for rhinoplasty based on anatomic variances.
