GENERAL INFORMATION

Intended Audience: This activity is designed for plastic surgeons at all levels of experience who want to increase their knowledge of the most up-to-date, innovative trends, procedures and strategies to implement in the practice of their specialty.

With regard to regulation we are including a regulatory update with a compliance packet.
