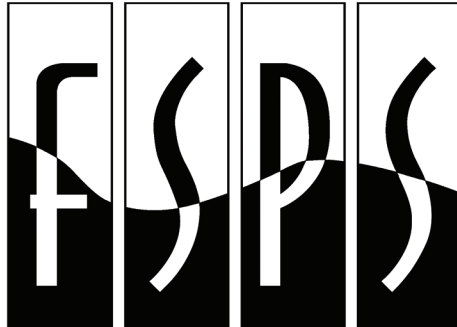

Disclosure Policies and Accreditation

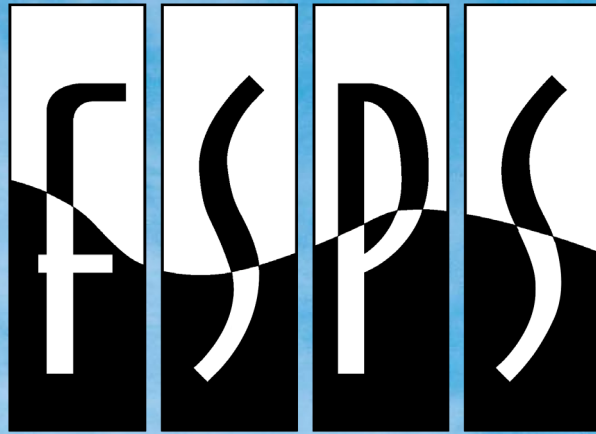
